



FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT



<u>Deacon Steve Szmutko's Reflection on the Sunday Readings</u>

<u>December 19, 2021 – Fourth Sunday of Advent</u>

<u>Micah 5: 1-4a Psalm 80: 2-3, 15-16, 18-19</u>

Hebrews 10: 5-10 Luke: 1: 39-45

"Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb . . . Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

The wait is almost over; the days before Christmas dwindle down to a precious few and anticipation is high. The readings for the Fourth Sunday of Advent point to the imminent birth of our Lord Jesus. The birth of the Messiah, the Christ, was long awaited and prophesized in the Old Testament. In today's Gospel, St. Luke describes the meeting of two women – Mary and Elizabeth – both of whom were blessed with child through unusual circumstances: Elizabeth, a woman advanced in years; Mary, a young virgin, with child through the power of the Holy Spirit. Their meeting was at once touching and poignant. It was, in a sense, a celebration of life, and

a recognition of the fulfillment of prophecy, hope and promise. It was the strong demonstration of the Holy Spirit: both in the Son of God, now carried in the womb of this young woman; and of the knowledge of this truth by her cousin, pregnant with the child, who would be known as John the Baptist.

Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, recognized Mary as the Mother of the Lord. Her own child, who would later baptize Jesus in the River Jordan, leapt with joy in her womb. What great faith! What an example of total obedience to God by these women of faith, who were entrusted with roles essential to the final fulfillment of the messianic promise: Elizabeth, the mother of the last and greatest of the prophets; Mary, the mother of our Lord and Savior. It was a moment of boundless joy, long awaited, yet never before or since experienced.

The obedience of the women in accepting and embracing God's Will, must have been a splendid example for their sons. Both grew to adulthood in fidelity to their mission. While Jesus, in his divine nature was the only begotten Son of God, the example of his mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, provided him with the example of perfect human conformity to the Father's will. In the Blessed Mother, we find perfection in faithfulness. In her own words, asserted her loving and unconditional trust: *Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.*" The trust exhibited by Mary and Elizabeth also serves as models of faith for all of us too. When God calls us, may we be open to him with joyful resolve.

As we anticipate the Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord, let us remember the total submission of Mary to serve humankind as the mother of Jesus. In her willingness to do God's will, she is the exemplar of devotion and humility – the model to which we all can aspire to emulate.




