

Knights of Columbus - Essay Contest – Grades 8-12

Ewing Council 3756 is sponsoring participation in the official Knights of Columbus Catholic Citizenship Essay contest again this year. It is open to students in grades 8 to 12 for the 2021 – 2022 Academic Year. In order to apply through Ewing Council, you must qualify by at least one of the following criteria. Each student may only enter one local Council Contest in a given year.

1. Live in Ewing Township.
2. Be a member of Incarnation-Saint James or Our Lady of Good Counsel parishes.
3. Attend school in Ewing Township.
4. Be a child or grandchild of a member of Ewing Council.

The theme for this year's essay is "In an essay of 500-750 words, describe everyday obstacles that you may have experienced or witnessed others experiencing while living a life of authentic faith. Explain how you have overcome these obstacles and how, by doing so, it has helped your faith to continue to grow."

Each essay must be typed and be between 500 and 750 words, and submitted along with an entry form. The student's name must appear only on the entry form and not the essay. Entry forms may be found in the back of the church.
